Terms of Reference

- 1. The purpose of the National Licensing Forum (NLF) is to provide a platform for discussion between the various member organisations on licensing and related issues. The NLF has a dual remit:
 - To discuss and identify solutions to current issues 'on the ground'. Including:
 - Practical application of licensing legislation
 - Unintended consequences of legislative change
 - To take a 12-18 month look ahead to identify significant issues/events with licensing implications.
- 2. The NLF will seek to promote a better mutual understanding of the issues faced by the regulators (at national and local levels) and the industry, and the implications of policy decisions / proposed changes to all parties.
- 3. The NLF will seek to identify through its members existing good practice and then use member networks to promote such practice.
- 4. The NLF is not a decision making or policy making body.
- 5. It will not be the norm for the NLF to make public statement.
